Composition

Each student participating in the Doctoral Internationalization Consortium in Information Systems has been assigned to a presentation/ breakout group (please refer to page 2 of this document). There are five students in each group. All the students within a breakout group will be mentored by two senior IS faculty members assigned to that group.

Objective and Activity

The objective of the breakout sessions is to position a student's research interests in the global context of technology, innovation, and management. To that end, **every student would be required to make a 30 minute presentation on a topic of their choice**. Each presentation would be followed by 30 minutes of Q&A and detailed discussion on how this topic is related to other topics in IS as well as how it can be positioned in the global context. This discussion would be led by the faculty mentors. Student presenters are encouraged to seek from faculty mentors advisement on issues raised in their presentations as well as advice that may be useful to their future careers.

The detailed presentation and discussion schedule within a group will be decided by the faculty mentors in that group.
